With the introduction of the Race Relations Amendment Act 2000 and the Religious Discrimination Regulation, there has been an increase in demand from Public Sector organisations for greater access to courses and information regarding the various cultures and religions that make up their communities.

This unique course is designed to increase your knowledge of Islam and help you to promote equal opportunities and equal access in service provision.
